Subject: Suspicious Death on the City Walking Bridge

Investigator: Corporal Woods

Description of the incident:

1. Local businessman, Mr. G Campbell was discovered deceased due to vital signs absent (VSA) in the center of the path, right in front of the city's walking bridge during the early hours of May 19, 2023. There were no indications of a struggle or any obvious signs of potential weapons at the scene. Mr Campbell was soaked in water from the heavy rains the night before, indicating that he had been there a good part of the night. However, a 2 by 4 plank was found just a few meters away from the location, near the tree line on the right side of the bridge. The body was stumbled upon by a local jogger at 6:00 AM local time. Mr. Campbell's body has been relocated to the coroner's office for further examination. It is worth mentioning that Mr. Campbell was under investigation for his suspected ties to organized crime. The scene was cleared and reopened to the public by 1:00 PM on May 19, 2024.

2. Evidence removed from the sight:

- a. Remains of Mr. G Campbell, and
- b. 2 by 4 wooden plank.

3. The following was noted during the initial investigation on site.

a. Weather over the past 24 hours was heavy rain with scattered thunder storms in the form of a atmospheric river.

b. The individual that found the body was Kim Gibbson and seemed very shaken by the event. She is being provided counseling.

c. Mr Campbell's clothing was soaked due to the over night weather, he had all of his personal items; Gold Watch, Wallet with \$259.46 cash, cell phone and set of house and car keys.

d. He was wearing what looks to be a tailored made silk pinstriped suit.

4. This death appears to be suspicious and warrants further investigation, especially considering the deceased potential ties to organized crime. Once the coroner's report is released, a thorough investigation needs to be conducted.
